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CONTEXT

Second Chance Schools' (SCS) approach was identified by the European Commission in 1995 as being **strategic to overcome some problems and effects arising from the high rates of early school leaving of young people** and the lack of systematic approach to promote and assure the lifelong learning for all. The low self-awareness, social alienation and restricted or reduced access to professional opportunities or career development of quality of these groups are some of the multiple effects that Europe is facing nowadays.

We believe that Second Chance Schools' approach is strategic for the capacity building and social, cultural and professional inclusion of young European adults.

S2CENE will invest on the creation and reinforcement of the social and politic status of SCS reveals to be strategic for the promotion of social inclusion, equal opportunities, and justice among European citizens.

OBJECTIVES

- 1** Creation of Second Chance Schools in 2 countries of the partnership (BG and HR).
- 2** Establishment of formal national networks of Second Chance Schools for adult education in 3 countries of the partnership (PT, BG and HR).
- 3** Institutional and positioning reinforcement of the European network of Second Chance Schools (E2C Europe – FR).
