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CONTEXT

Second Chance Schools' (SCS) program was launched by the European Commission 20 years ago as a strategic measure to address the serious social problem of low qualifications and employability of young people. The measure widespread across Europe, although at very different levels of development, integration in education and training systems and sustainability.

SCS have been proving their relevance and efficiency in addressing early leaving from education and training and social exclusion of young people, reengaging learners in education by developing high quality training programs based on their needs, desires and abilities and offering young people a safe and friendly space to discover themselves and to build their life projects. SCS are nowadays strategic in Europe for the capacity building and social and professional inclusion of young adults.

S2CENE will invest in strengthening the social and political status of the SCS, as a key policy measure to promote social inclusion, equal opportunities and justice among European citizens.

- 1 Introducing Second Chance Schools in 2 countries of the partnership (BG and HR).
- 2 Establishment of national networks of Second Chance Schools for adult education in 3 countries of the partnership (PT, BG and HR).
- 3 Institutional and positioning reinforcement of the European network of Second Chance Schools (E2C Europe – FR).
