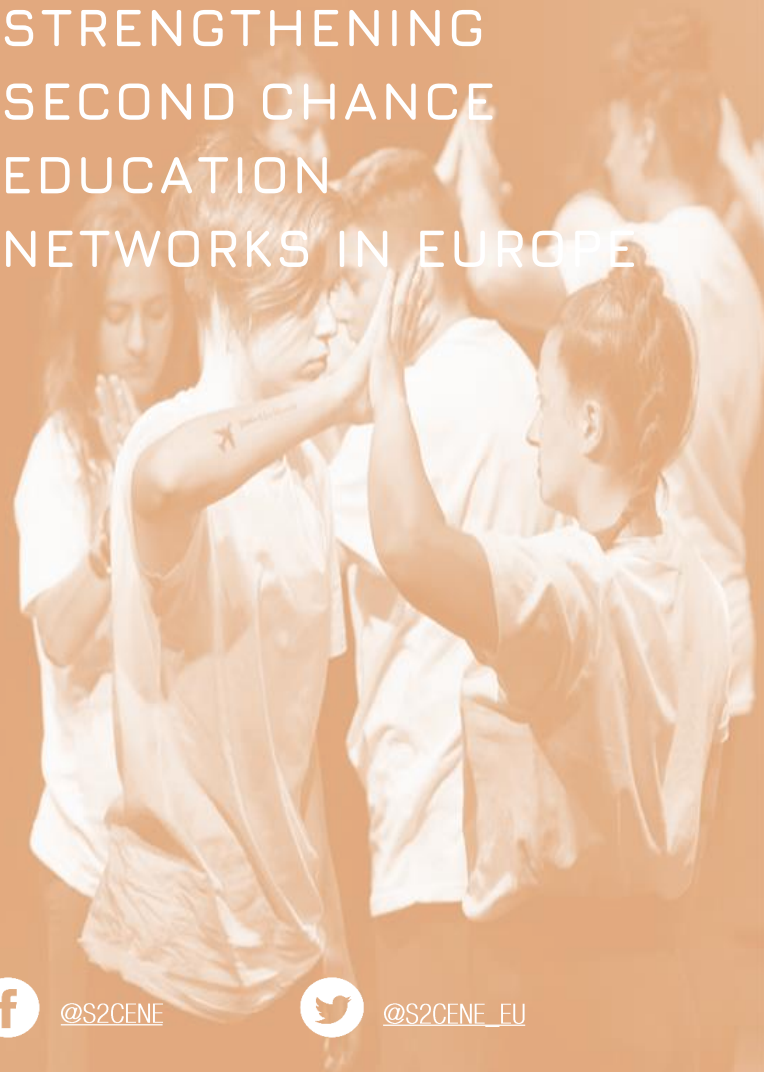

CONTEXT

Second Chance Schools' (SCS) program was launched by the European Commission 20 years ago as a strategic measure to address the serious social problem of low qualifications and employability of young people. The measure widespread across Europe, although at very different levels of development, integration in education and training systems and sustainability.

SCS have been proving their relevance and efficiency in reengaging early leavers in education by developing high quality training programs based on their needs, desires and abilities and offering young people a safe and friendly space to build their life projects. SCS are nowadays strategic in Europe for the capacity building and social and professional inclusion of young adults.

Erasmus + KA3 "S2CENE" project have invested, along the 3 years of the project duration (2020-2023), a lot of efforts in strengthening the social and political status of the SCS, as a key policy measure to promote social inclusion, equal opportunities and justice among European citizens.
